## News From Presbytery

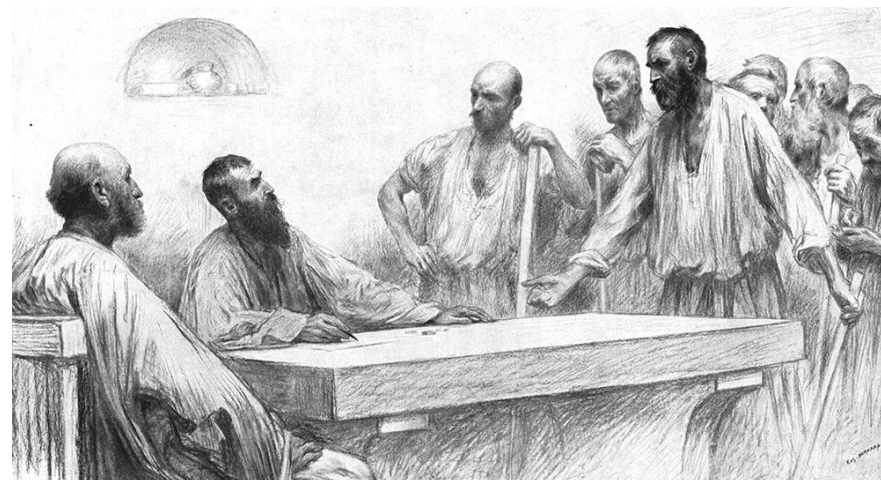
St. Andrew's was awarded a grant for \$4000 from Presbytery's Congregational Support Fund for Session's new "On-Line" Ministry Proposal. (This follows on from the earlier Friday Night LIVE Proposal.) This will enable St. Andrew's to purchase specialized equipment for live-streaming and recording our Worship Services.

Lakeshore St. Andrews (LSA) has a new "lead pastor," Rev. Brian McGuffin, as of Sept 14<sup>th</sup>. He is officially a "Lay Missionary with Special Training" and is from the Presbytery of Winnipeg. He was originally ordained in as a Baptist and is presently in the Evangelical Mennonite Confederation. He has an MA in Theology from Huron College, and is applying to Education and Reception into the PCC. Brian is also studying for a D.Min in association with Wycliffe College, Toronto.

Presbytery has approved the Amalgamation of St. James and First Presbyterian Church, both of Chatham. St James' final Service of Celebration will be on Oct. 25<sup>th</sup> at 2:30pm.

University Community Church, Windsor, is getting a *new* minister: Rev. Shalini Rajack-Sankarlal (formerly of St. Andrew's Ajax). Her Induction Service is on Oct 4<sup>th</sup>, 6:30pm.
