News from Presbytery (from Feb 16th Meeting)

- a) Presbytery approved its Ministry & Doctrine (M & D) Committee's recommendation that 2 assessor elders join Knox, Leamington's Session - one as Clerk of Session. Rev. Shirley Murdock (as Clerk) and Bob McVicar have now joined Knox's Session as of Feb 24th, with M & D approved Terms of Reference.
- b) To help in the pastoral care of ministers and those in stated pulpit supply, Presbytery will be meeting informally, bi-monthly and by zoom, for unstructured encouragement and sharing.
- c) The Session of Paulin Memorial *and* Presbytery have approved Sarah Stockford as a suitable candidate for ministry as a candidate for Ministry of Word and Sacrament.
- d) Brian McGuffin, lead pastor at Lakeshore St. Andrew's Church (LSA) is preparing his application to the Committee on Education and Reception.
- e) A new process for regular Presbytery visitation teams to congregations is being designed.
- f) A grant of \$5k from the Congregational Support Fund was approved to assist St. Andrew's Dresden in establishing an on-line ministry through the use of new technology.

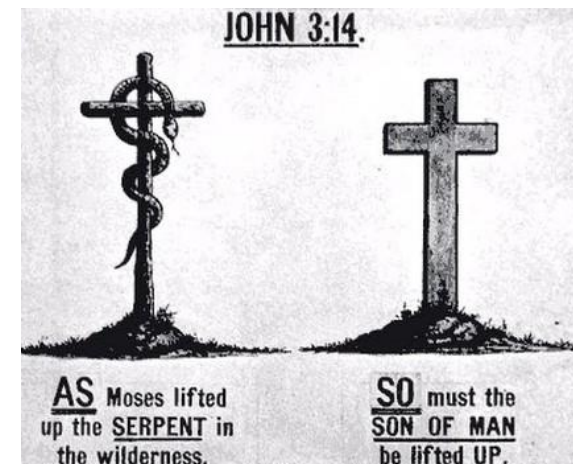
