**News from Presbytery**

1. Rev. Leslie Walker has resigned as Minister of Knox, Leamington, with effect from May 31<sup>st</sup>.
2. This arose as a result of Presbytery's Review of Ministry Team's final report which was received and approved by Presbytery, via Ministry and Doctrine Committee.
3. In that report there were a number of recommendations specific to Knox's congregation too.
4. Moreover, Assessor Elders (Rev. Shirley Murdock, as Clerk of Session, and Bob McVicar) have be assisting Knox's session since Feb 24<sup>th</sup> and will continue in that capacity for a further seven months.
5. Rev. Lilian Wilton will be Knox's Interim Moderator, starting June 1<sup>st</sup> 2021.
6. Following the resignation of Doug Cameron, Rev. Mike Maroney is now the Interim Moderator of New St. Andrew's Dover.
7. Rev. Andy Cornell replaces Rev. Leslie Walker in the role of Presbytery Commissioner at General Assembly.
